Course Warnings

Watch For Cars- There are 2 left turns across traffic on the course
Left Turn from El Paso to Dobie will likely have Gravel in Corner
Right turn on Crest off Dobie is on a down hill
Right Turn on SE 4th of Sand Hollow is obscured by trees
SE 4th has a high speed right sweeper into a neighborhood-Watch for dogs and gravel
Right Turn on Brill off Elgin is immediately after a canal.
The 1st 100 meters of Brill is hard pack dirt. There is one other short section of dirt.
Right turn on County Line has bad pavement on the inside of the corner
OTHER HAZARDS LIKELY EXIST--RIDE SAFELY AND WATCH OUT FOR YOURSELF

- Start - Bill Burns (head east)
- Right on Bowman
- Left on South Slope
- Right on Little Freezeout
- Right on Hollow
- Right on El Paso
- Left on Dobie (Dobie becomes 11th)

- Right on Crest
 - Left on SE 10th
 - Right on Sand Hollow
 - Right SE 4th -
 - Left on Elgin -
 - Right on Brill -
 - Right on County Line Road
- To Course Split at intersection of County Line and Dewey

To Do an El Paso Loop

- Right on Dewey (becomes El Paso)
- Right on Dobie
- Then follow same route back to Intersection of County Line and Dewey.

To Finish:

- Left on Dewey
- Right on Brogan
- Left Bill Burns
