Swan Falls Dam Individual Time Trial – May 13, 2005

A rolling 15km individual time-trial course starting at the base of the Snake River Canyon at the Idaho Power's Swan Falls Dam complex. This former HP Women's Challenge TT course will present riders with a demanding initial 1.4 mile climb out of the canyon followed by 6 miles of gradual downhill ending with an uphill climb to the finish.

Kuna Butte Road Race – May 14, 2005

Starting in the town of Kuna, this 20 mile road race loop goes around Kuna Butte presenting to the riders a steep steady climb with several other shorter climbs and rollers mixed in. The finishing stretch is flat and fast. Perfect for a bunch sprint. The course consists mostly of right hand turns with left hand turns at the very start of the race and at the very end of the race. This is not a closed road course. Bonus Omnium points can be gained in the road race (refer to Race Bible).

Team Dobbiaco/Satchel's Grill Downtown Criterium – May 15, 2005

This 1km Criterium course centered in downtown Boise, ID has long and fast front/back stretches with tight turns. The roads are smooth and flat. Points primes will be awarded during the Criterium (refer to Race Bible).

Omnium Guidelines: The Treasure Valley Omnium follows the rules and regulations for Omnium races as outlined in the 2005 USCF Rulebook. Omnium points only accrue to riders in the Omnium. One day riders are not eligible for Omnium points. Refer to the Race Bible for Omnium Point Schedule.

Prizes/Awards: \$2000 in total cash prizes. Juniors will receive awards. Cash prizes are 5 deep in each category general classification and are only awarded to Omnium riders. One-day riders not eligible for GC cash payout. Refer to Race Bible for cash breakdown. The promoter reserves the right to reduce the prize amount if turnout is low.

Race Fee: Omnium: Men CAT Pro/1/2 (\$55); Women CAT 4 & Juniors (\$20); All other Categories (\$45). Individual Stages: \$25 (Juniors: \$5). Register at www.sportsbaseonline.com **A \$10 increase for day of race registration.**
