STAGE ORDER

Performing Arts Center Prologue: Friday, June 30, first rider off at 7:00 p.m. Start order on reverse. Fantastic new 1-mile prologue with a climb at the bottom and a technical finish loop at the top. Riders who can't make it to the prologue can start the stage race with slowest prologue time in their class + 5 seconds. Take I-15 to the Clark St. exit (#69) and head down the hill. Turn left on 15th Ave. at the light, and then left again at the light in front of Reed gym. Prologue parking and start in the lot adjacent to and behind the gym.

Marsh Valley Road Race: Saturday, July 1, 9:00 a.m. (NOTE EARLIER START TIME!) Take I-15 to Arimo (about 30 miles south of Pocatello). Take exit 40, and go east a quarter of a mile to England's Sinclair Station. Course is the same as in past years: rolling, 17.5 mile loop on county roads with good pavement, one climb, and little traffic. Drink lots of water! Feed zone on east side of course, same as in 2005.

Truckerville Time Trial: Saturday, July 1, 6:30 p.m. (NOTE REVERSAL OF COURSE DIRECTION!) Take I-86 west of Pocatello to the Rainbow Road exit. Park on the west frontage road extension. Out-and-back course is flat with good pavement. Start order same as for prologue and criterium. Within each class, riders will start in reverse order of GC. Start times will be posted at the time trial start and as specified in the race bible.

Holt Arena Criterium: Sunday, July 2, 8:00 a.m. From Clark or Center Streets, turn south on 15th Ave. to the ISU campus. Holt Arena is on your left. Follow signs to parking. Course is 1km in length with good pavement, 7 corners and a short hill.
