Allan Butler (1976-2005), an Idaho Falls native, began bicycle racing as a teenager. He moved to Salt Lake City to pursue his sport, winning the Utah state road championship in 1996. His numerous career victories included the Logan-to-Jackson Classic in 2000. In 2005, he won the Gate City Grind Stage Race on his way to claiming the overall title in the Utah Cycling Association points series. He was hit and killed by a taxi cab in Las Vegas in the fall of 2005 while attending a bicycle trade show. Come join ICE and Allan's family in celebrating his life and sport in the first criterium ever held in his hometown!
