The White Knob Challenge Cross Country Race

This NORBA classic cross-country race returns **Saturday August 2**. Racers take off from Main Street on a 9-mile ascent that features 2,300 feet in elevation gain, followed by a rip-roaring roller coaster descent to the valley floor.
