Allan Butler (1976-2005), an Idaho Falls native, began bicycle racing as a teenager. He moved to Salt Lake City to pursue his sport, winning the Utah state road championship in 1996. His numerous career victories included the Logan-to-Jackson Classic in 2000 and the Gate City Grind Stage Race in 2005, the year he won the Utah Cycling Association points series. He was hit and killed by a taxi cab in Las Vegas in the fall of 2005 while attending a bicycle trade show. Come join Allan's family in a celebration of his life and sport in his hometown!

**Course and Directions**: Flat, 1-km, L-shaped course in the heart of historic downtown Idaho Falls. Take I-15 to Idaho Falls. Exit at Broadway and go east. Start/Finish at Great Harvest Bakery, Park and A streets.
